Who is at risk of getting COVID-19?

- Seniors; 65+.
- Infants (under the age of 1).
- Children with underlying medical conditions.
- Anyone with an underlying medical condition.

You **qualify** for the vaccine if you:

- Are over 16 years of age or older for Pfizer, Moderna, or Johnson and Johnson.
- Are 12 years of age or older for Pfizer.

If you are pregnant or nursing, consult your doctor before getting the vaccine. If you are allergic to any component of the COVID-19 vaccine or have had allergic reactions to vaccines in the past, consult your doctor before receiving the vaccine.

How to get Vaccinated

- Check if you are eligible.
- Make an appointment or find a walkin clinic.
- Bring proof of age in form of an ID card, Passport, etc.
- If you receive the Pfizer or Moderna, confirm your second dose.



Types of Vaccines

- Pfizer- given in 2 doses, 21 days apart.
- Moderna- given in 2 doses, 28 days apart.
- Johnson and Johnson- given in 1 dose.
